

☐ The University of Mazandaran is the largest higher education center, a comprehensive and designated university in Mazandaran province.















It has a history of more than half a century, the initial core of which has been formed by the School of Economics and Social Sciences, the Sari School of Agricultural Sciences, the Gorgan Faculty of Agriculture and Natural Resources, the Babol Noshirvani Technical Teacher Training Center, and the Babolsar Postgraduate Education Center. On September 16, 1979, and with the approval of the Supreme Revolutionary Council to merge these centers, the University of Mazandaran was officially established and has experienced significant growth in both quantitative and qualitative areas in recent years.



□ Currently, the University of Mazandaran has 466 faculty members, 12,041 students, 262 majors, and 490 foreign students. The comprehensive development plan of the University of Mazandaran was implemented in the city of Babolsar on a land area of approximately 200 hectares, and approximately 160,000 square meters of educational, research, welfare and dormitory, administrative, and cultural space were created.
